Background

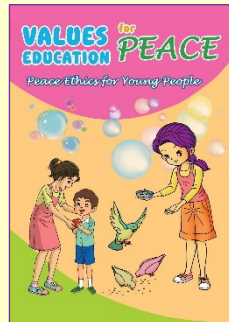
